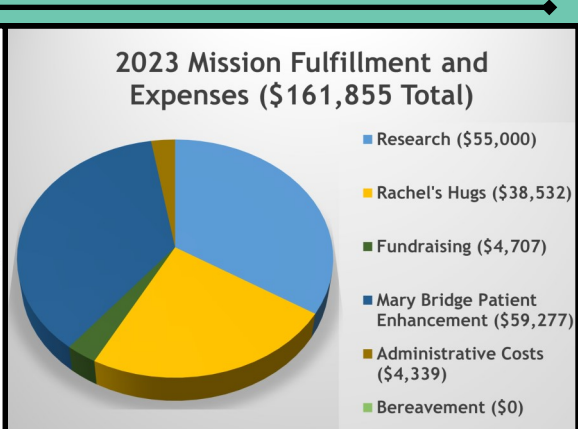
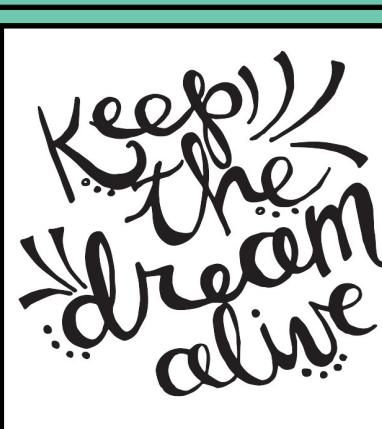
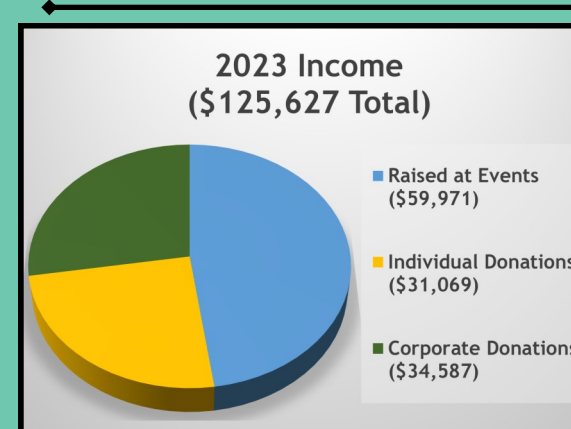
Rachel's Hugs Expands to Madigan Army Medical Center

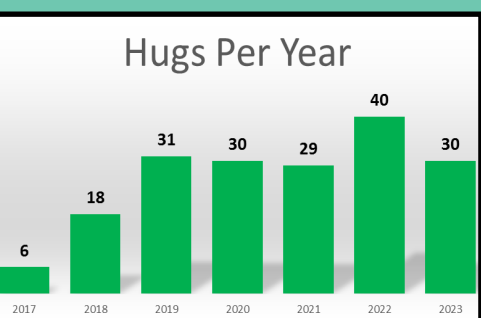
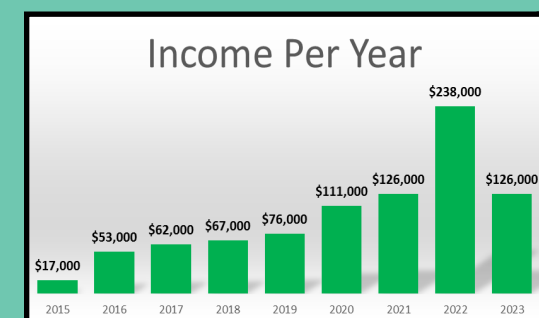

Funding Research

We are committed to making direct donations to key pediatric research programs to bring hope and cures to kids and families. We also had the chance this year to learn more about the oncology clinical trials program in place at Mary Bridge. We learned that with additional funding, they can offer more clinical trials, which means more treatment options, closer to home. In 2023, we provided donations totaling \$55,000 to research and associated work being conducted in Seattle, and clinical trials at Mary Bridge. We know that the hope this research provides to families is incredibly meaningful.



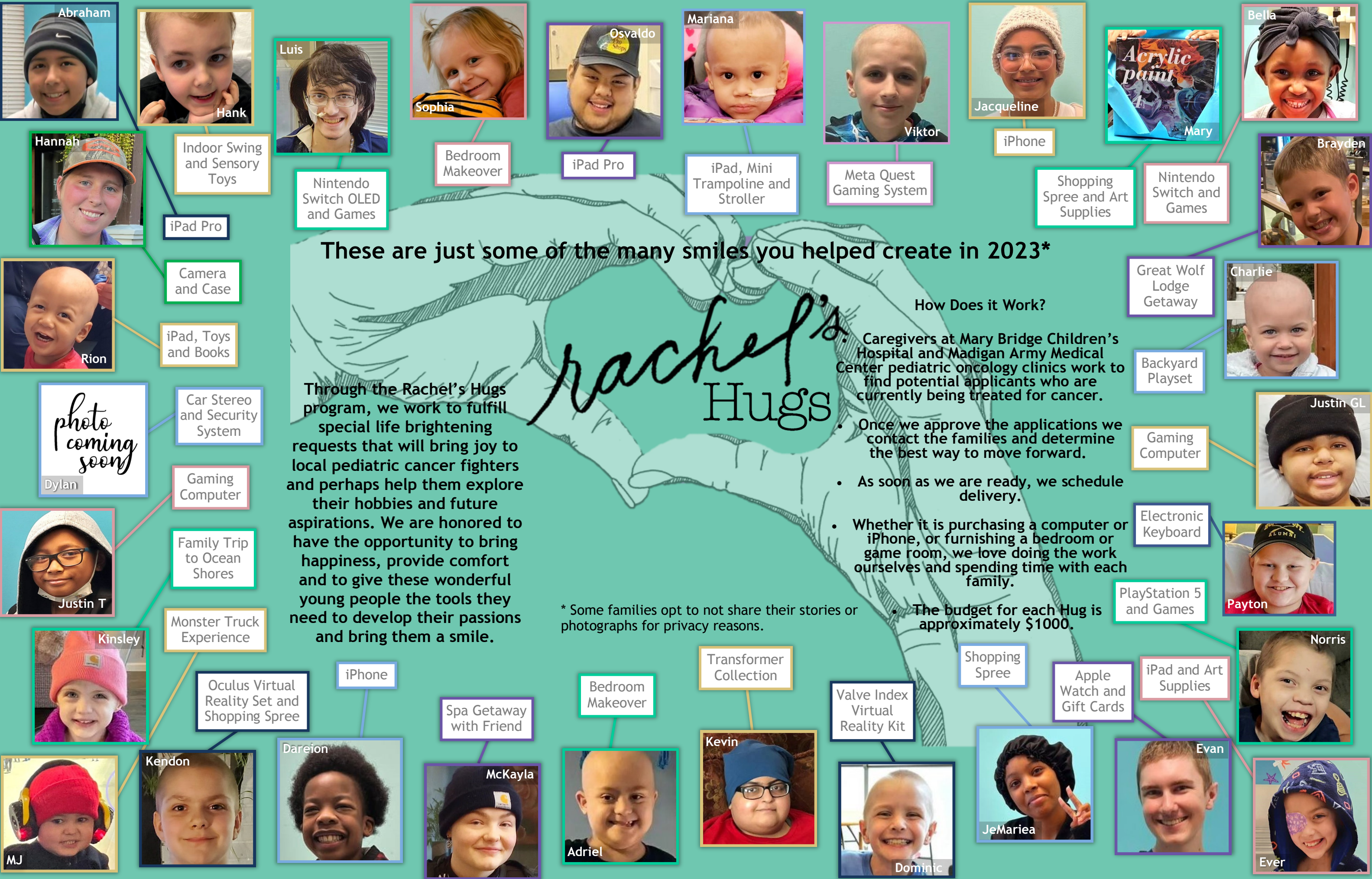

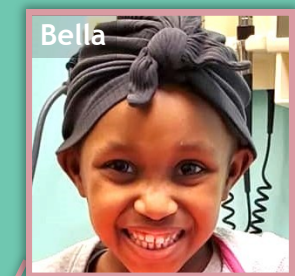
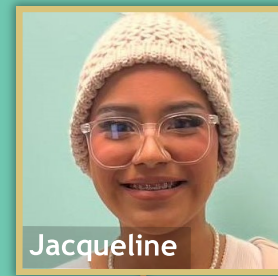
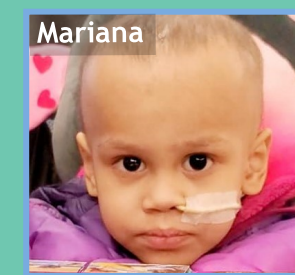
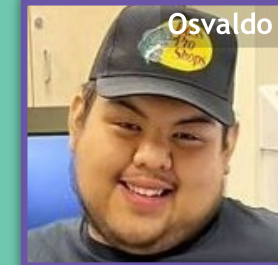
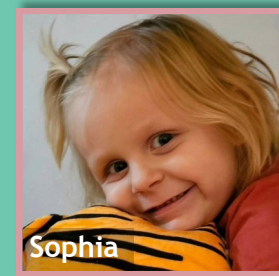
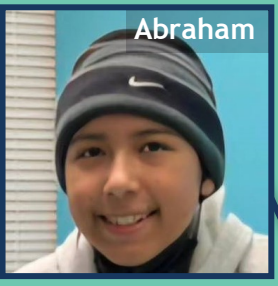
Rachel's Hugs

How Does it Work?
